## What do you think about your municipality?

### **How the information is used**

The collected data will be presented in tables and graphs, which should give an idea of what local residents think about their municipality. In order to not burden you with more questions than necessary, the answers you submit will be supplemented with information that Statistics Sweden already has. That is gender, age, civil status, country of birth (in groups), citizenship (in groups), education and income.

Besides being used by Statistics Sweden, the survey information may be used by researchers. These types of research and statistics operations are also covered by statistical confidentiality (see below). Release of data is restrictive and is subject to special consideration.

### **The information you submit is protected**

When the information is presented, no single individual can be identified.

The information you submit is held confidential under Chapter 24, Section 8 of the Public Access to Information and Secrecy Act (2009:400). All those who work with the survey at Statistics Sweden are required to follow the regulations concerning confidentiality.

Regulations on the handling of personal data are also found in the Personal Data Act (1998:204), the Official Statistics Act (2001:99) and the Official Statistics Ordinance (2001:100).

### **Information about personal data**

Statistics Sweden is responsible for the handling of personal data that is processed by Statistics Sweden.

You have the right to receive information free of charge once per calendar year on personal data about yourself that is handled by Statistics Sweden. To obtain this information, you must make a written request which is to be signed by the person that the information deals with. If you believe that Statistics Sweden has handled your personal information in a way that is not in line with the Personal Data Act, you have the right to request that your personal information is corrected, blocked or erased.

The number at the top of this letter and at the back of the form is there to enable Statistics Sweden, during data collection, to determine who has answered.
