
Changes in CPI as from 2020


Major changes in the production of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) as from 2020 are described below. The CPI for January will be published on Tuesday 19 February.


New data on fuel

As from 2020, transaction data will be used in all subsets of surveys concerning fuel prices. This includes Diesel (6214), Petrol 98/99 (6220), Petrol 95 (6221), and E85 (6225). Prior to 2020, price information was collected via telephone from a sample of service stations over a three-week period each month. The change in 2020 means that all prices from the largest enterprises in the fuel market are included. The measurement period will cover at least the first 25 days of the month. For each pumping station, the price per product will be calculated as a weighted unit value for the month. Otherwise, the same method as previously will be applied. The impact on the total CPI is deemed to be negligible. For the time period from January 2018 to December 2019, the differences in effect on the yearly change in the CPI have been estimated to be no more than 0.03 percentage points.












Figure 1-4: Price index for fuel with the new data and published index

Better input for sample of mobile phones and computers

As from 2020, Statistics Sweden will use new sales data material, which will lead to better conditions for maintaining a representative sample of mobile phones (6416) and computers (7713) in each survey. This data will also be used to calculate the weighting factors in home electronics. The index will be calculated using the same method as previously.
