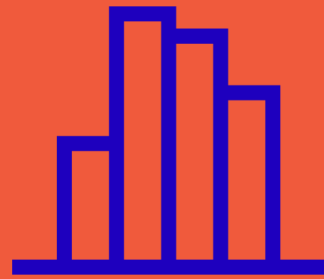

Timely and useful statistics

- Official statistics describe aspects of Sweden and contribute to the development of society by being objective and relevant, to the benefit of the citizens.
- The statistics are comprehensible and trustworthy, allow comparison over time and between groups, and reflect regional conditions.
- The statistics are up-to-date and available on time.



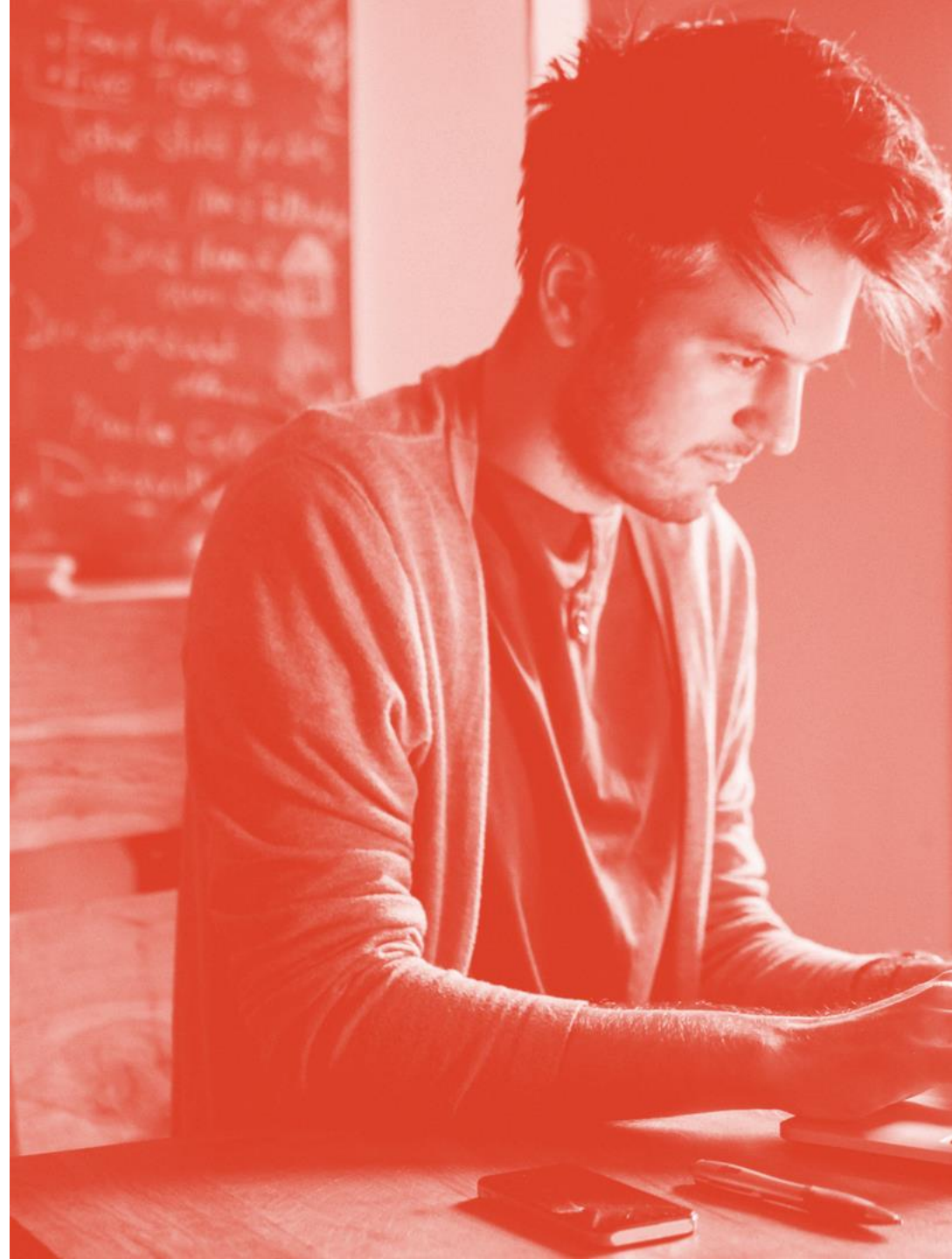
Timely and useful statistics

- The statistics can be used as a basis for highlighting issues such as equity, gender equality and sustainability.
- We are in dialogue with users of the official statistics to ensure that the statistical content offers a good opportunity to follow social development.
- We place the statistics in a context, provide support for understanding the statistics and work towards ensuring coherence.



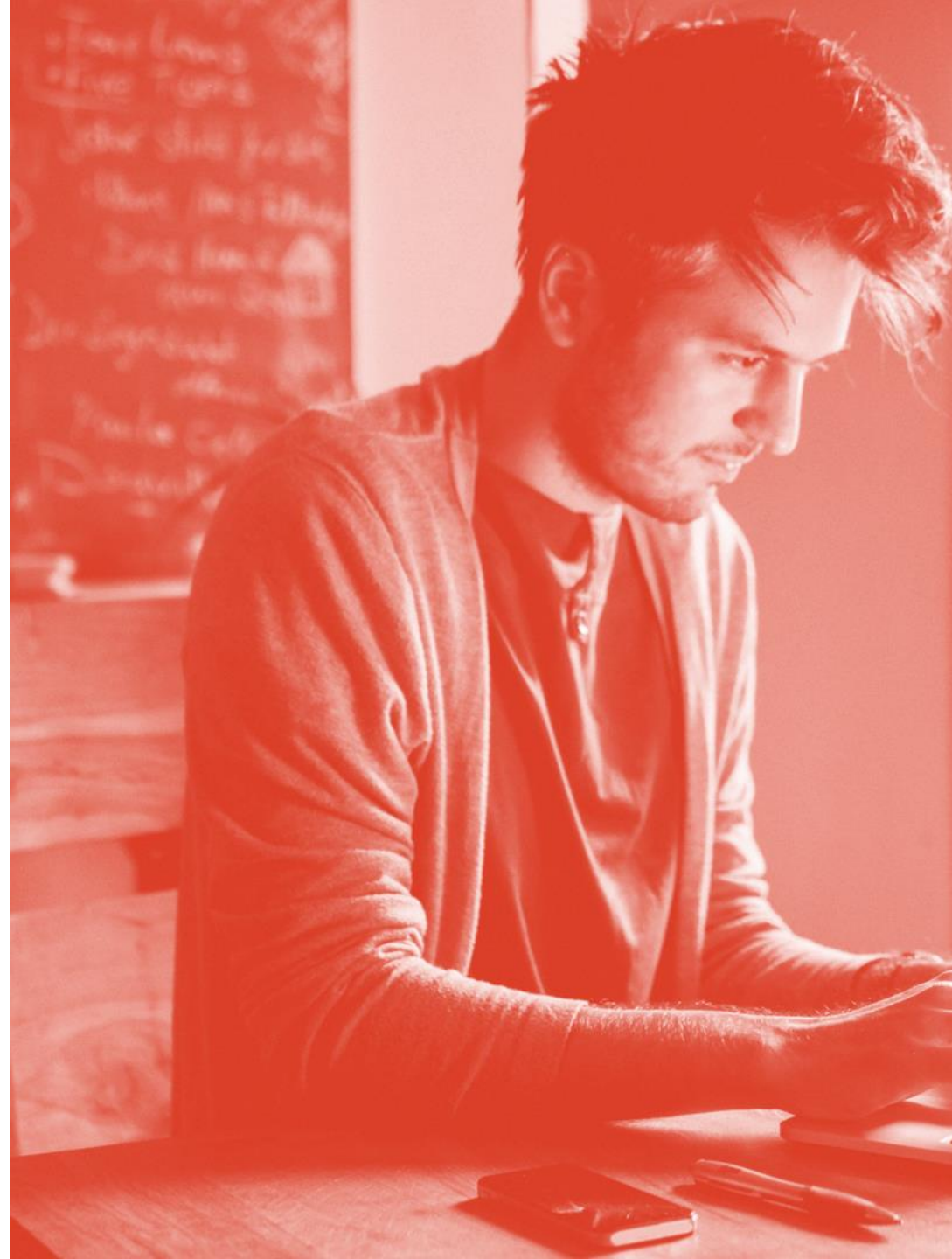
Finding what you seek is easy

- Official statistics are easy to find, use and retrieve.
- Publishing as much as possible of the official statistics as open data makes it easy to process further.
- We enhance the benefit of official statistics by visualising, detailing and explaining the statistics to both experienced users and novices.



Finding what you seek is easy

- We have a well-functioning service for statistics and microdata, if the official statistics are insufficient.
- Subject to approval examination, microdata is released efficiently and securely for research and statistical purposes.



Smart and secure data capture

- Together with public and private data owners, we have established a national, overarching architecture for secure, efficient and quality-assured data access to official statistics.
- It means we only need to request each item of information once from companies and organisations.
- We are gradually developing the architecture to comprise more data sources.



Smart and secure data capture

- We can share data efficiently, free of charge and securely between government agencies responsible for statistics.
- Direct collection is a last resort.
- We use methods that can capture data in new ways and from multiple sources.



Doing it better together

- The Swedish statistical system is strengthened and developed in cooperation with all government agencies responsible for statistics.
- We share our methods, tools and processes to ensure cost-effective high quality official statistics.



Doing it better together

- We draw on national and international progress to jointly improve the system of the official statistics.
- We regularly carry out analyses on ways to improve the system for the official statistics and submit proposals to the Government as needed.
