What is a publication ?

About STATSHOW

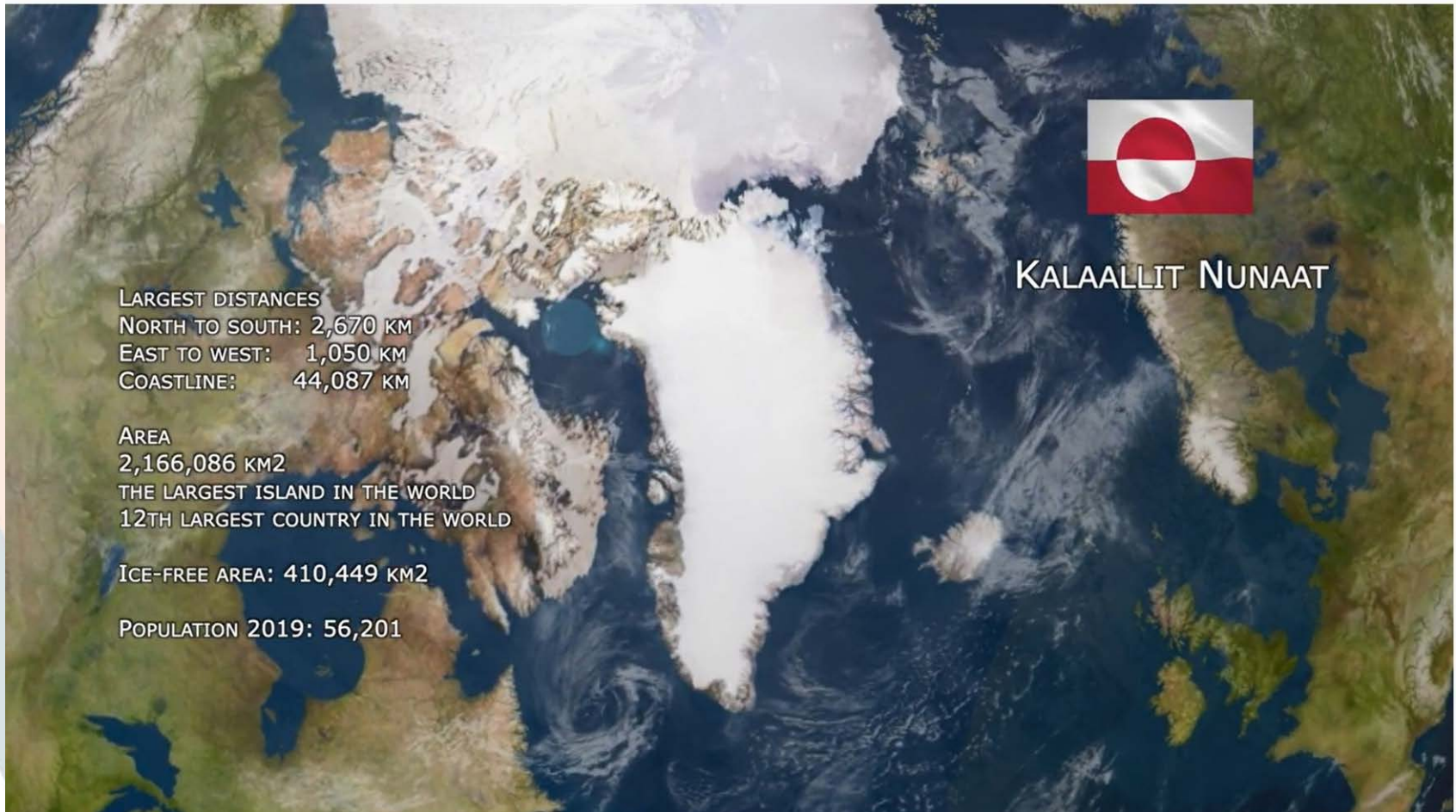
The coding++ is done by a Danish consultant, who used to work at Statistics Denmark
